Community Reminders!

- Fences residents need to obtain written approval from BFH in advance, only certain fences are approved.
- Parking for boats, trailers, recreational vehicles, pop-up campers, camper shells, and utility trailers is prohibited in the community, except twenty-four (24) hours before or after use for the purpose of loading, unloading or cleaning.
- Upon extended absences (7 days or more), we ask that residents notify the appropriate neighborhood management office. This practice is requested so if any unusual activity is present during your absence, management can respond on your behalf or can notify you.
- Christmas lighting may not be erected before Thanksgiving and must be removed no later than January 10th. Outside decorative lights are to be turned off no later than midnight, except on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve, when they are allowed to remain on overnight. Outside lights are not authorized during daylight hours. Outside lighting must be Underwriters Laboratories (UL) approved and factory listed for outside use. Running electric cords through windows and doors, or across heating ducts or vent systems is prohibited, as this causes a fire safety hazard. All exterior lighting must be "GFI" protected. Residents are reminded that homes have limited amp circuits and care must be taken to prevent overloading.

Cleaning Tips: The ideal time for trash can cleaning is on trash day, right after trash pickup or before filling up the can.

- 1. Move the container(s) to some place you don't mind getting wet and somewhat soapy, the lawn would be ideal.
- Squirt some dishwashing liquid into the bottom of your empty trash container(s) and use a sprayer attached to your garden hose to "pressure wash" the inside of can.
- 3. Pour out the soapy water & rinse.
- 4. Turn the container(s) upside down with the lid open to let all the water drain out.
- 5. Turn the container(s) right side up, with the lid open and let it dry in the sun all day.
- 6. Spray inside of the container(s) with disinfectant.
