Don't forget to put your cans away by 6:00pm the following day.



Cleaning Tips: The ideal time for trash can cleaning is on trash day, right after trash pickup or before filling up the can.

- 1. Move the container(s) to some place you don't mind getting wet and somewhat soapy, the lawn would be ideal.
- 2. Squirt some dishwashing liquid into the bottom of your empty trash container(s) and use a sprayer attached to your garden hose to "pressure wash" the inside of can.
- 3. Pour out the soapy water & rinse.
- 4. Turn the container(s) upside down with the lid open to let all the water drain
- 5. Turn the container(s) right side up, with the lid open and let it dry in the sun
- 6. Spray inside of the container(s) with disinfectant.
