## 12 months of Fire Safety ~ April

- Put a lid on a grease fire to smother it, then turn off the heat, baking soda will also work.
- Never move a burning pan.
- Never throw water or use a fire extinguisher on a grease fire. Water will only spread the fire and the force of the extinguisher can splash flaming grease out of the pan.
- Never leave food, grease or oils cooking on the stovetop unattended.
- Keep pot handles turned inward to prevent accidental spills.
- Create a three-foot "child-free zone" around the stove. Keep children and pets away from the stove while cooking.
