MAINTENANCE TIPS

Staying Cool This Summer

The **thermostat** signals for the system to heat or cool your house. It does not control the temperature of the air coming out of supply vents. The thermostats only control the on/off function and signal to shut down the system once the satisfied temperature is met. There are 2 primary switches on the system.

- Mode Settings: Set to Cool during summer and leave the fan on Auto.
- Fan On simply circulates air without cooling it, while Fan Auto ensures the air is cooled before circulating.

In extreme heat, your unit typically maintains about a 20-degree difference between outdoor and indoor temperatures.

- Example: If it's 100°F outside, your home may stay around 80°F inside.
- As temperatures drop in the evening, your indoor temperature will improve.

Tips to Help Keep Your Home Cool

- Keep blinds and curtains closed during the day.
- Use blackout curtains to block heat.
- Keep your garage door closed.
- Run ceiling fans to circulate air.

These small steps can make a big difference in keeping your home cool and your system running efficiently!
