Wood Chips Boost Flavor: Using wood chips are a quick and easy way to switch up your recipes and infuse food with unique flavors.

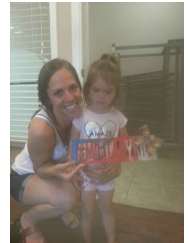
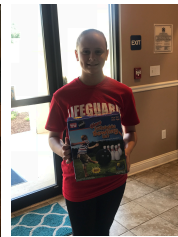
